

Feoffees of St Michael's Spurriergate York – The Role of Feoffee

From time to time, we have vacancies on our board of trustees or “Feoffees”.

The charity is no longer associated with St Michael's church. It now awards grants towards the maintenance of Church of England churches in York and also for general charitable purposes within the city. These are restricted to the area within the City's boundary as defined in 1974. The role is to manage the charity and ensure that its grant making is in accordance with the above objects.

What would you do?

We meet on a quarterly basis at a city centre location (or remote link if required) together with any other work arising out of the charity's activities as we are a small team. Becoming a Feoffee will enable you to make a practical contribution towards some of the needs of Church of England church buildings and the people of the City of York. Through this you would have the ability to make a real difference.

What skills do we need?

We look for a knowledge of the City of York and its needs and an ability to work collectively with fellow feoffees.
